SUBJECT: Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5310 Grant Funds

The California Department of Transportation has notified its sub-recipients that there are Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 grant funds available for Dial-A-Ride (DAR) services.

Staff is requesting approval from the HTA board to apply for three (3) Class A W/C equipped transit vehicles in the amount of \$213,600, of which \$170,880 is to be paid with 5310 Grant Funds and \$47,720 is to be paid with matching funds or if approved, Toll Credits.

The vehicles would replace three older cutaways that were transferred from the City of Eureka and the Humboldt Community Access & Resource Center. Based on FTA standards, these vehicles have surpassed their useful life for service. Having newer equipment will for the regions DAR service will reduce maintenance costs, reduce road calls, and improve on-time performance of the overall system.

<u>Action Recommended</u>: Adopt Resolution 19-07 Authorizing Application for FTA Section 5310 Grant Funds and the General Manager to Sign the Grant Agreement.

# Authorizing Resolution RESOLUTION NO. 19-07

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FEDERAL FUNDING UNDER FTA SECTION 5310 (49 U.S.C. SECTION 5310) WITH CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

**WHEREAS**, the U. S. Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to states through the Federal Transit Administration to support capital projects for non-urbanized public transportation systems under Section 5310 of the Federal Transit Act (**FTA C 9070.1G**); and

**WHEREAS**, the California Department of Transportation (Department) has been designated by the Governor of the State of California to administer Section 5310 grants for transportation projects for seniors and individuals with disabilities; and

**WHEREAS**, The Humboldt Transit Authority (HTA) desires to apply for said financial assistance to permit operation of paratransit service in Humboldt County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Humboldt Transit Authority has, to the maximum extent feasible, coordinated with other transportation providers and users in the region (including social service agencies).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that the Humboldt Transit Authority does hereby authorize Greg Pratt, HTA General Manager, to file and execute applications on behalf of Humboldt Transit Authority with the Department to aid in the financing of capital projects pursuant to Section 5310 of the Federal Transit Act (**FTA C 9070.1G**), as amended.

That Greg Pratt, HTA General Manager, is authorized to execute and file all certification of assurances, contracts or agreements or any other document required by the Department.

That Greg Pratt, HTA General Manager, is authorized to provide additional information as the Department may require in connection with the application for the Section 5310 projects.

That Greg Pratt, HTA General Manager, is authorized to submit and approve request for reimbursement of funds from the Department for the Section 5310 project/s.
